**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ECUADORIAN
CITIZENS (PRE-SELECTED BY MINEDEC)**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Clermont School of Business, located in Clermont-Ferrand – France, is a triple-accredited (AACSB, AMBA, EFMD) French institution that trains responsible, globally minded leaders through innovative, sustainability-driven programs and strong international and corporate partnerships.

The **Clermont School of Business** and the Ministry of Education, Sports and Culture of the Republic of Ecuador – MINEDEC, within the framework of international relations and cooperation, announce a number of **10** scholarships for those Ecuadorian candidates who have been preselected by MINEDEC for the academic year 2026-2027. These Scholarships will allow holders to study Graduate (Official Master) Studies.

The scholarship granted in the framework of the cooperation with MINEDEC, belongs to an exclusive and specific discount granted to Ecuadorian citizens.

DESCRIPTION OF ITEMS NOT COVERED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The scholarship does not include:

- The application fee of €50 euros (non-refundable) corresponding to the online application process.
- The average annual costs of living in France, which are of €7.380 euros, (this amount includes the main expenses: housing, food, insurance, as well as bills electricity, internet, phone) and the average price of airplane tickets, to and from France. (€1000 euros, each one)

Clermont School of Business does not offer housing facilities on campus; however, it works with a private agency, which helps international students secure accommodation near the campus. The beneficiaries of the scholarship would be able to be benefited of this service.

III. REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must:

1. As a first step, interested people who meet the requirements established below and wish to obtain any of the scholarships called for in these guidelines, as a first step must complete the University application form/link/registration by entering the following link:

2. Submit all the required documents in Pdf format via email to MINEDEC to becascooperacion@gmail.com with the following subject: Candidate's name-Institution-year/ call. E.g PerezJuan_ClermontSoB_Master2026
 - 2.1 Copy of valid passport or national DNI.
 - 2.2 Copy of the undergraduate (bachelor's degree or equivalent) diploma legalized through the Hague Apostille issued by the Ecuadorian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and

- Human Mobility. In case of not having the diploma yet, candidates should present instead a certificate issued by the University where it states the candidate's status as graduated and explains the reason why the candidate hasn't received the diploma.
- 2.3 Copy of academic transcripts. (For all years of study).
 - 2.4 Certificate of registration of the Undergraduate degree issued by MINEDEC. The certificate can be downloaded from the following Link:

 - 2.5 Curriculum vitae
 - 2.6 Motivation letter
 - 2.7 Two (2) Recommendation letters (One page letter, to be addressed to the International Relations Department of Clermont School of Business, no specific topics required)
 - 2.8 English language proficiency, demonstrated by one of the following:
 - TOEFL ITP: Minimum score of 550
 - IELTS: Minimum score of 6.0
 - TOEFL iBT, Cambridge English, or TOEIC (750) also accepted
 - 2.9 Proof of having concluded the online application process (first step). The applicant is allowed to present one of the following options:
 - A screenshot of the confirmation message that the application was successfully received or registered
 - A document proving completion of the online application

Additional obligatory step: The applicant, after completing the online application, will receive an invitation link by email to complete an automated video presentation through a special website that Clermont School of Business is using. The video evaluates applicant's motivation, study background, experiences and interpersonal skills. A skype interview may also be requested. (This is an additional required process, but it is not required to be included as part of the documents to be submitted to MINEDEC) -

If the documents are originally issued in a different language other than Spanish or English, they must also include a Sworn/ Certified translation.

In order to be eligible for the scholarships convened in these guidelines, candidates must:

- a. Have been preselected by MINEDEC for this scholarship program and submit the documentation required by the University, in full as described above.
- b. Hold Ecuadorian nationality and/or reside in Ecuador.

IV. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

The submission of documents ends by **30th of June, 2026**

V. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

1. The submission of the application implies the acceptance of these guidelines for the scholarship program.
2. **Clermont School of Business** and the Ministry of Education, Sports and Culture of the Republic of Ecuador, both reserve the right to extend the deadline established for this call if they deem it appropriate, or to suspend the aforementioned program due to budget constraints.

However, in case of early termination, students who are already enrolled and/or carrying

out their studies within the framework of joint cooperation will not be affected.

VI. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDING CRITERIA OR METHODOLOGY (SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING PROCESS)

Clermont School of Business will notify the final beneficiaries of the scholarships between July 20th and 31st, 2026 via the e-mail registered at the University online application form.

VII. OBLIGATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The grantees who are convened by these guidelines are obliged to:

- a. Use the scholarship for the purpose for which it is granted, that is, to study the chosen Master program for which the scholarship has been awarded, without it being possible to subsequently request a change of program once the scholarship has been granted, unless it is canceled or all its available places have already been covered,
- b. Assume responsibility of paying the items not covered by the scholarship.
