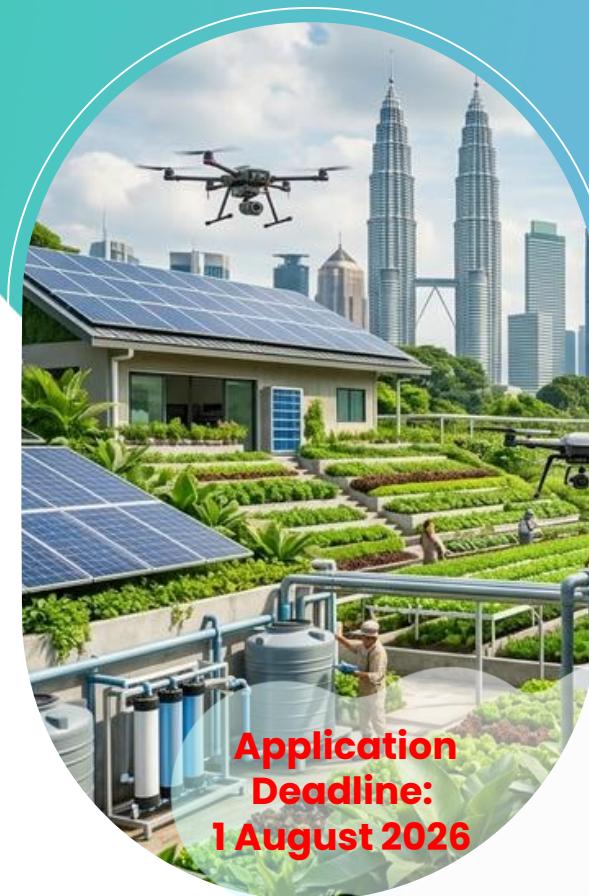

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was initiated at the First Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) for Asia Pacific Region held in Sydney in February 1978. It was officially launched on 7th September 1980 at the 2nd CHOGM in New Delhi, India to signify Malaysia's commitment to South-South Cooperation, in particular Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).

The MTCP is conducted through the sharing of Malaysia's development experiences and by providing training and technical advice in key areas that are important for the development of a country. Since its conception, technical and capacity-building programmes under the MTCP have benefited more than 40,000 participants from participating countries.

FELLOWSHIP / SCHOLARSHIP

Under the MTCP programmes, the Government of Malaysia will be providing:

Accommodation

Participant will be accommodated at a hotel/hostel within the vicinity of the training institute. **Participants are strictly not allowed** to bring any family members during the course. Accommodation will be on a single room basis.

Daily Allowance

Participants will be provided with a daily allowance during the official course duration only.

Meals

Meals will be provided throughout the duration of the course.

Air Fares

A return economy class flight ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur is provided for participants. Tickets will be issued upon confirmation of acceptance.

Course Fees

All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia

Dress Code

Participants are required to dress in formal or office attire throughout the class sessions as well as during official visits to Government Ministries / Agencies.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Only complete applications that are made through the MTCP website at <https://mtcp.kln.gov.my/courses2/list2> will be considered. Select the course name and click "Apply Course" to generate a new application form.

Applicants are required to complete the online application form, upload a passport sized photo, and provide a self-introduction video. A draft link will be sent via email and must be accessed using a One-Time Password (OTP) and submitted within seven (7) days. The manual for the application process can be found on the MTCP Website.

All application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of candidates' respective countries and should be submitted only through the diplomatic channel via Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission of Malaysia.

Successful candidates will be duly notified by MARDI Corporation one (1) month before the commencement of the course.

Incomplete and/or unendorsed forms will not be considered.

Application DEADLINE : 1st AUGUST 2026.

VISA AND VACCINATION

For **countries that require a visa** to enter Malaysia, you must apply for **eVISA before departing**.

- Upload the necessary travel documents through the system.
- Ensure that all documents are scanned clearly for the smooth process of approval.
- eVISA fees and related costs are to be borne by the participants.

- Bring along the eVISA and all the necessary travel documents for the arrival in Malaysia.
- For **countries that do not require a visa** to enter Malaysia, may enter with **Social Visit Pass**.
- Participants from countries listed in <https://www.imi.gov.my/index.php/en/main-services/visa/visa-requirement-by-country/> are required to take mandatory vaccination for Yellow Fever at least ten (10) days prior to their departure to Malaysia. Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is required upon landing in Malaysia.
- Participants must ensure that their passports are valid for at least six **(6) months** prior to the date of travel.
